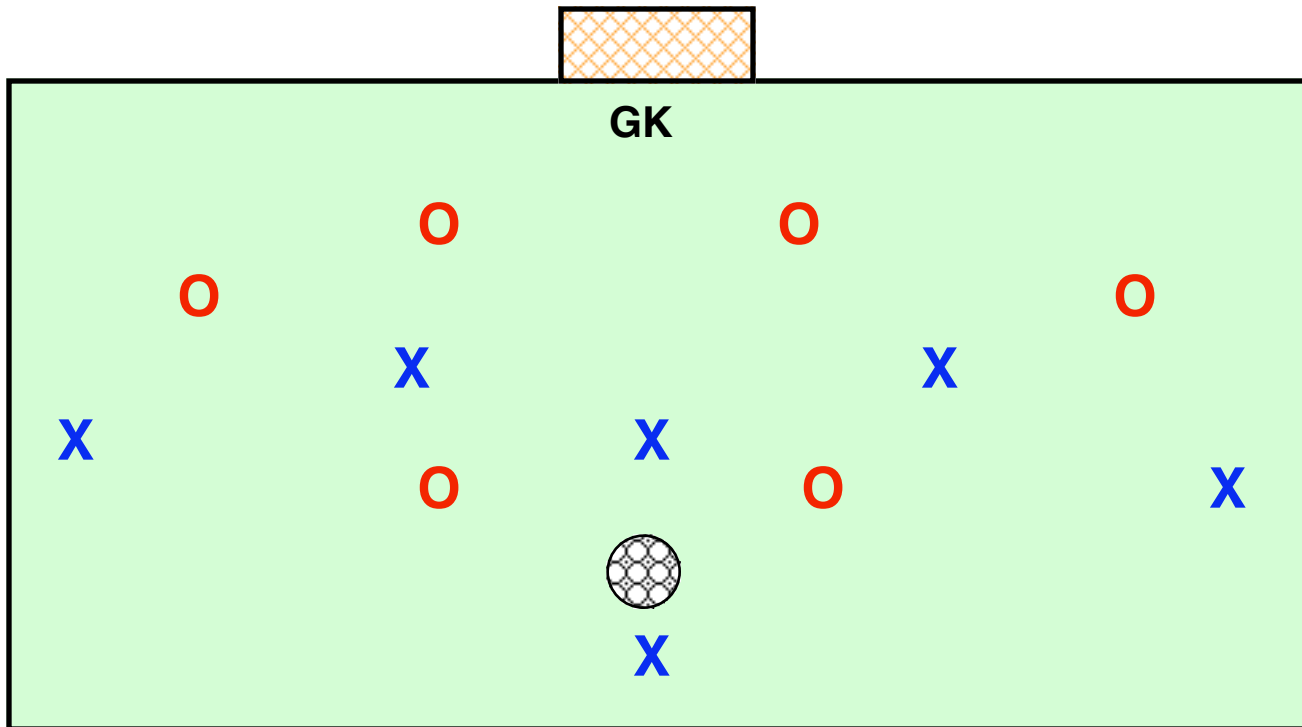


# TACTICS: Possession, Attacking

## "KEEPAWAY vs. GOAL ATTACK"

*This drill is designed to teach players transition and possession :  
 going from offense (attacking the goal) to defense (regaining possession)*



**NUMBER OF PLAYERS:** Eight (8) to 18, divided into two (2) teams + Goalkeeper

**GRID/FIELD SIZE:** Depends on number of players  
 -- from 22 yards wide x 18-yards long (18-yard box) to half regulation field

**GAME:**

- > One (1) team starts as attacking team (in diagram above, Blue Team "X")
- > One (1) team starts as defending team (in diagram above, Red team "O")
- > Object is to score goal

**Example:**

- in diagram above, if Blue Team "X" scores goal, they maintain possession but now play "Keepaway" vs. Red Team "X", who attempt to gain possession of the ball and attack the goal
- teams transition from offense (attacking the goal) to defense (possession, keepaway) every time it scores a goal
